



VICTORIAN CLUB PERMIT SCHEME

FAQ'S Question 1- May I use my Club Permit Vehicle for a family wedding?

Answer: Yes, the logbook requires an entry. Note that a CPS vehicle cannot be used for hire or reward hence a regular business in wedding transport is not permitted.

FAQ'S Question 16- Can I sell my vehicle with CH plate and can the plate be transferred to the new owner?

Answer: Yes provided the new owner belongs to the same club. The vehicle will need to be re-permitted to new owner by submitting a new application, a RWC and the appropriate fee to VIC Roads.

OLD SCHOOL STORIES

The Holden Torana appeared in 1967, a small car which evolved from the imported Vauxhall.

We looked forward to 1968 with a rumoured Brabham enhanced version. It arrived- 2 door, 4 speed, twin side draught carbs, noisy exhaust, 12 inch wheels, bonnet stripe, blacked out grill and tail panel, front disc brakes, rack and pin-

ion steering, chequered flag badges front, sides and rear.

The 12inch wheels (diam.) were 4 inches wide. The engine 1159cc, not quite 1.2litres was no bigger than a lunch box and put out 59kW. Fairly underwhelming stuff. BUT: that little engine must have been well engineered as it produced 49.2kW/litre capacity, a figure only

exceeded by the 1972 E49 Charger at 51.8kW/l. The XY GT HO came third at 48.2kW/l. Most engines at the time were in the region of 35kW/litre. Humble beginnings but rectified to the extreme in Aug 1974 with the option L34 Torana.






