

MAKE YOUR OWN CAR WASH DETERGENT RECIPE

Prepare in advance for your next few car washes by making your own condensed cleaner base. Pour $\frac{1}{4}$ cup baking soda into 4 litres bucket/jug, then add $\frac{1}{4}$ cup dishwashing liquid and enough water to fill it almost to the top. Mix well, and store the concentrate for later use.



Tiny Teddy Cars

Ingredients:

- 100g milk chocolate, melted
- 1 bag Milky Way bars (you will need 24)
- 1 box Tiny Teddy biscuits, honey flavour
- 1 bag Smarties (340g)

Method:

Set out a tray or serving plate for the Teddies.



Sort the Smarties into colours and cut 12 Smarties in half with a sharp knife or use other round lollies e.g. life-savers.


Remove the wrappers from the Milky Way bars.

Cut 24 Tiny Teddies in half at the belly button using a sharp knife.

Place the melted chocolate into a resealable bag and snip a tiny corner off. Squeeze out a few drops of chocolate to glue 4 Smarties 'wheels' on each car then place on the serving tray. Place a few drops of chocolate on the top of each 'car' and sit the Teddies on. Place a drop of chocolate on the 'car' in the front of each Teddy and glue on steering wheels.

OLD CAR MAINTENANCE



Best way to look after your “old” car is to use it. Bit like us “use it or lose it”. Batteries stay healthy when kept charged and a solar charger is good for this. Araldite the plug somewhere around the grill for easy connection/disconnection. To help with initial start in the cold weather and tight motor, the car battery might like the help of a jump starter. This can be kept charged by using a small charger via a plug in timer giving short bursts which you can set up to maintain a full charge.



For carby cars an electric fuel pump is good to prime the carb, or a squirt of ‘Start ya bastard’ through a straw sized hole in the air cleaner into the carb throat, makes things happen. Check electrics occasionally because terminals, switches, relays, fuel senders etc. need current through them to keep contacts clean. Brake lights can be checked by using a length of conduit (because it flexes) between seat back and brake pedal. Most cars need ignition on for this test. When washing your car – give the windscreen wipers a bit of a go. Test the horn.



Brakes are probably the parts that gum up quickest from non use – pistons develop a gunky build up. I like to work brakes whilst driving (when there’s no one behind) maintaining constant speed and using left foot for numerous light pumps of the brake pedal. Disc brakes especially benefit from this as they use centrifugal force to return pistons and effect movement in caliper housings.

Whilst out driving;

- 1) run air conditioner for a while.
- 2) use heater to circulate fresh water.
- 3) top up with some fresh fuel – petrol can go stale.

Presumably you do the basic checks – oil, water, tyre pressures and periodically the brake fluid level.

Lastly – don’t forget to fill out your Log Book.



Requirements for signing Club Permit Scheme (CPS) Forms.

Effective 17/11/2014

VICROADS require clubs to maintain up to date CPS info; to ensure our club maintains accurate records of club permit vehicles the following procedure has been implemented.

The club member must:

Present their club permit paperwork to one of our authorised signatories (preferably at a monthly club meeting) and provide a photo of the car including the number plate. The photo is to be supplied by the owner and can be emailed to the signatory prior to having the form signed or by presenting a print or transferring by phone at the time of signing.

The club Member must also present their current Membership card at the time of signing.

The CPS signatory must:

Ensure a photo of the car has been presented and the licence plate is legible. Then take a photo of the applicant's membership card prior to signing the permit forms to prove the member is a current financial member of the MMCC. Once completed the signatory will then stamp, date and sign the paperwork as required. The signatory will then forward the photos to the head signatory for processing and filing.
